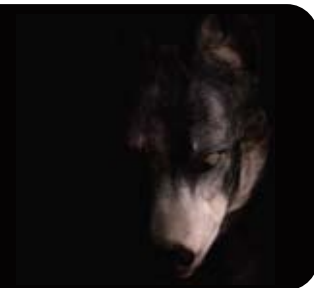

The Wolf Eyes Defender 170 is a compact high intensity LED torch with high 170 Lumen output. Often chosen by Police Officers, the Defender 170 wears a push button tactical tailcap. The Defender 170 includes a fast 3 hour charger, LRB 168A battery and regulated 170 lumen digital LED.

The Defender Digital 170 series features a bright 170 lumen disorientating strobe output strong enough to temporarily disorient or disrupt an individual's night vision, perfect for self defence use or as a non lethal tool for officers of the law. It is similar to the preflashes before a camera flash, but lasts much longer.

The brightness level is a similar level of light output to the standard black baton like lights used in the past by many Police Forces in Australia. The difference is Wolf Eyes Defenders are pre focussed, meaning they are always in focus irrespective of whether they are aimed 2 metres or 50 metres away. There are no annoying black holes in the beam either.

The low level is perfect for writing by, putting out a similar amount of light to a popular 2 x AA cell light.

Constructed of aircraft grade aluminium which is then anodised in a non-reflective tactical black, the Defender's construction is extremely durable.

The Defender series is similar to the Sniper series, but with a crenulated bezel which projects 15mm in front of the flashlight lens. This allows one to observe if the torch is on if it is placed bezel down, but also protects the lens if used to smash glass (such as when a first responder arrives at a car accident or house fire) or used as a last ditch impact weapon for self defence.

While the Defenders can use standard non rechargeable CR123A batteries like many older torch designs, they also have the ability to use the environmentally and wallet friendly Lithium Ion rechargeables, the same technology used in many mobile phones. Unlike most rechargeable batteries, Lithium Ion batteries have a very low self discharge rate, able to hold their charge for up to 10 years. The LRB 168A (18650) battery is acclaimed as one of the most powerful and energy dense batteries in its size and is often used in packs in notebook computers. It has over 30% more capacity than the 17670 used in other older rechargeable solutions. It is nice to know that your torch will be working when you call on it.

Part of the Wolf Eyes modular system, replacement modules and optional accessories are available such as a holster, rechargeable kits, Wolf Eyes Lamps, Lumens Factory high output lamps, car charger, additional batteries, filters (red, UV & Infra Red), gun tailcaps (straight & coiled) and gun mounts.
